Idling Wastes Gas

Idling wastes 6 billion gallons of fuel annually in the U.S.

Idling Pollutes

A gallon of fuel creates about 20 lbs. of greenhouse gases.

Idling for just an hour uses up to a gallon or more of fuel depending on vehicle size.



Idling Wears on Your Engine

An hour of idling is the same wear-and-tear on an engine as driving 33 miles.

Idling Wastes Gas

Idling uses up to a gallon or more of fuel per hour depending on vehicle size.
